

## Evaluation System (Primary Section)

At our school, we emphasize stress-free education, implementing the Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation (CCE) system. This approach includes both formal and informal assessments throughout the academic year, ensuring a well-rounded evaluation of students' progress. It involves regular assessments, frequent informal evaluations, periodic tests and performance analysis, allowing for timely corrective measures to enhance learning and understanding.

The evaluation system follows a structured method for assessing students' progress. The academic year is divided into two semesters:

**1st Semester : June to October**

**2nd Semester : November to April**

### Important Notes:

- ▶ The First Semester Report Card will be evaluated out of 100 marks.
- ▶ The Annual Progress Card will reflect marks calculated out of 100. (i.e.  $200/2=100$ )
- ▶ Gujarati subject will not have formal tests for Std. I & II.
- ▶ For Std. I & II, final results will be declared at the end of the academic year.
